1. MCQ Competition

- 2. Each participant will be given a set of question paper containing 40MCQs.
- 3. MCQs would be from different 6 areas (Entertainment, General English, Sports, Logical Reasoning & Aptitude, IT Trends and General Awareness)
- 4. Time limit 45 minutes (15 minutes for reading MCQ and 30 minutes for attempting)
- 5. OMR sheet will be provided.
- 6. No negative marking.
- 7. Each question will carry one mark.
- 8. All questions are compulsory.

2. Poster Competition

- 1. Topic for Poster Making "Atam Nirbhar Bharat".
- 2. Time limit for the event is 1 hour.
- 3. All work must be done on the spot and must be completed within the duration
- 4. The participants will be provided A3 size white sheet only.
- 5. Participant has to bring their own stationary material (Pencil, eraser, sharpener, colours etc).
- 6. All the students must reach on time.
- 7. Decision of judges will be final.
- 8. Only Individual can participate.

3. Debate Competition

- 1. Topic for debate "Self-Reliant India (Vocal for Local)"
- 2. Individual participation.
- 3. Language can be Hindi and English.
- 3. Maximum 04 + 01 minutes will be given to each team to express their views on the topic during debate covering both sides In favor and against.
- 4. Decision of judges will be final.

4. Ideation Activity:

1. Rules: Business Plan_(Blazing the trails of Tomorrow)

- 1. Team may comprise of maximum two members.
- 2. Team would represent Business plan either through Model demonstration or through PPTs.
- 3. Time limit is of 10 minutes. After that 5 minutes will be taken by Judges for question-answers.
- 4. Decision of judges will be final.

2. Rules : Product Launch/ Robotic Implementation-

- 1. Product Launch / Robotic Implementation may be submitted by individuals or by teams.
- 2. There must not be more than 4 members (In case of team).
- 3. Executive summary, containing the expansion of concepts outlined must be sent through e-mail on or before April 05, 2021.
- 4. The subject of the e-mail should be Product Launch/ Robotic Implementation.
- 5. Teams should bring soft copy in CD and Hard copy while attending competition.
- 6. Decision of judges will be final.

5. <u>CHESS Competition</u>

1. Timings and clocks – The purpose is to keep track of the total time each player takes for his own moves. The players may take more or less time over any individual move, but if one player exceeds their total available time, that player has lost the game. Another important rule is that if a player runs out of time, their opponent must point it out, and if it goes unnoticed, play continues.

2. No interference – When the game is in progress, no third party is allowed to interfere in the game. If you are attending any chess tournament then you are allowed to walk through the playing area but provided you do that quietly. You are not allowed to make any suggestions to the players regarding their game. If you do so, it is regarded as a violation of rules. A player is also not allowed to ask for help from the audience or any other person.

3. Distractions – Chess is a quiet and focus-needing game and therefore the players need no distractions. All disturbing behaviors like making noises, talking, moving tables or chairs are forbidden. Exceptions are when you want to indicate rules violation, such as an illegal move.

4. Illegal moves – If the chess player makes any illegal move then the Arbiter shall give an extra time of 2 minutes to the opponent player. If the same player makes the second illegal move in the same game then the Arbiter shall announce the game lost by the offending player.

5. Conduct of the players – All the players must observe the code of conduct that is common for all the players. Players are not allowed to take any action that will bring the game to disgrace, e.g cheating, sneaking the captured piece back. During a tournament, the use of mobile phones or other electronic means of communication is completely forbidden. If it is evident that a player brought such a device into the playing venue, he shall lose the game.

Players should not distract or annoy their competitors in any way.

Decision of judges will be final.
