Nuclear Deal with Japan Artical By- Sumit Rana



he Prime Minister of our nation Mr. Narendra Modi has successfully signed the nuclear deal with the Japan's Prime Minister Mr. Shinzō Abe. This deal was signed on November 11, 2016. This move has boost up bilateral economic and security ties. The two countries had reached a broad agreement for cooperation in civil nuclear energy sector during Japanese Prime Minister Visit to India in December last year but the deal was signed this year in

2016.

The deal allowed Japan export nuclear technology to India, making it non-NPT first (Non-Proliferation Treaty) to have such a deal with Tokyo. It would also cement the bilateral economic and security ties as the two countries warm up to counter an assertive

November,

Japan is a major player in the nuclear energy market and an atomic deal with it will make it easier for U.S. based nuclear plant makers Westinghouse Electric Corporation and GE Energy Inc. to set up atomic plants

in India as both these conglomerates have Japanese investments.

This deal is important for Japan, mainly for economic reasons. Its heavy industries like Mitsubishi and Hitachi are also in the nuclear energy field, and they are running in loss because of Fukushima disaster. These companies desperately need new markets and what better market than our nation. But initially Japan opposed the Indo-US Nuclear deal, as India wasn't a member of Nuclear Suppliers Group (NSG) but later changed its position after realizing that it's going to be the sole looser in lucrative Indian market.

But, why this deal is important for India?

The deal is important for India to secure advance nuclear reactors for sites coming up at Gujarat an Andhra Pradesh. India has always looked up to th Russians and French for nuclear reactors, bu


> since more advanced designs are available with other countries like Japan and Unite States, India felt a need to diversify it options, that is why the civil nuclear deal signed with those respective countries India pursued these deals to addres India's energy needs.

Both the countries took several rounds of negotiations for this deal, which also helpe

to resolve several stick issues. But cutting th deal wasn't easy, ther were several question and concerns raised i the past that delaye the agreement. 

If you still want to be a farmer, you have a choice to make. Traditional farm or an indoor one. There are many pros and cons for both, but it comes down to this:


- You live in an urban setting and accessible or economically viable plots of land are not easy to come by.







tartup is basically a newly established business. A startup is a young business that is just beginning to develop. Startups are usually small and initially financed by an individual or a handful of people. These people try to offer a product that is not currently available in the market or they have a better substitute for an inferior product that is available in the market. As startups, they often require financing, it can be funded by bank loans or you can lend money from your family and friends. Startup comes with a big risk in investing because it will not guarantee you that you will earn money from it, maybe it will throw you in deep debts.

" A startup is a company working to solve a problem where the solution is not obvious and success is not guaranteed, "says Neil Blumenthal cofounder and co-CEO of Warby Parker,

There are no hard and fast rules on defining a startup since revenues, profits, and employments numbers shift drastically between companies and industries, we've figured out the chatter or coworking spaces and employees to start concretely defining a startup.

In recent years, startups with tech companies are growing rapidly. For example 'Uber', the car-hailing app which has raised whopping \$307 million total funding for a reported valuation of \$3.5 billion, really is a startup? Well, a multinational logistics company which will generate a reported \$213 million in revenue this year. Certainly, startups often adapt technology to solve problems and the ubiquity of that technology people have access to the internet, while mostly everyone have smartphonesallows critical growth. Though it often is, a startup does not, by definition, have to be tech-oriented. And when a tech startup has grown so big it's generating multimillion dollar profits, we should acknowledge its status as a startup graduate.





Recently Google made an Artificial Intelligence Program called as Giorgio cam, which can identify the object you capture in a photo and also describe the details of the object.


